This is the first home for the girls started in the City of Coimbatore in 1979. More than 1000 young children have lived here and studied here and gone out into the world with many success stories. The homes have made the children and shaped them not only physically but also emotionally and spiritually. It will soon be 40 years since the home began.

CHALLENGES FACED

MAINTANANCE:

The Building is almost 35 years old, and no major renovation work has been done. But there are constant repair works and maintenance every year. Some of the challenges they face is: The pipes for borewell water used for cooking, cleaning, washing, bathing purposes is rusted and need replacement due to high salinity of the water. There is a solar water heating system, but it stops functioning due to the high salinity of the water. So it is a challenge for the little children to take bath in the cold water in the mornings. A Desalination plant is the solution for the water here. Insufficient water in the campus, borewell needs to be fixed.

GOVERNMENT:

The government is not very friendly towards the Christian institutions. Also there are a lot of formalities, 5 approvals are needed from the government to get the license to run the home. 1. Health Certificate 2.Fire Certificate 3.Thasildhar (Govt.Authority approval) Certificate 4. Building Stability Certificate 5. Building Licesnse and Property Taxes. So the cost of getting this has become very high and the work strenuous, that the maintenance part of the home, is a challenge for the Institution heads.

OLD STUDENTS

Saranya works as an Accountant for a company in Coimbatore. One girl Kadeeja is a Dental nurse in London. Dulsy works as a Government school Head Teacher. Some of these girls are doing ministry today. Eswari and Jothi are successful businesswomen in Tirupur and Coimbatore respectively. Kumari works as a health assistant. Devakirubai is a prophet and ministers in Palani. Punitha, runs the orphan home for boys in Kovaipudur. Mallika works as a computer operator in a company and her sister works as a Physician assistant in a famous hospital in Coimbatore.
