I feel overjoyed, seeing them serve every week, and it just makes me want to stand up and shout God's goodness.





In our first year, at a time when we were renting everything from the microphone to the speaker, God challenged me to take an offering and sow into another North Indian church. Though we had so many needs of our own we decided to obey God's voice and took an offering and sowed into another Church. I believe its because of that seed, God has helped buy our own mixer, one of the best speakers, monitors mics and even a drumset. We are on the verge of buying a video projector.

One day as guests were coming home my wife informed me that the gas cylinder was empty, we did the only thing we knew. I laid my hands on the gas cylinder and prayed that it would not stop working. God heard our prayer and the cylinder lasted for more than ten days! Pioneering a church was hard on our finances not only for the church but also for our family. Facing the next day was always a challenge to us but time and time again we saw the miraculous provisions of God.
