DESIRE

I would like to open up my heart and share with you the Purposes of my life which I believe would be an example and inspiration for your life as well. The lives of many people in the bible inspire us to live a Godly life and do great things for God, like David (65 chapters and 1200 verses), Abraham, Elijah, Paul and so on. Many Biographies of saints inspire me and have touched my life. The Prayer of Oswald Chambers has changed my life and

has led me to surrender my life to God for His plans,

In 1954, I was born as the third son to my parents Dr.Job and Ruth. I was 10 when God saved me and at 13 I obeyed the Lord in water baptism. I had two dreams when I was a teenager. One of them was that I was preaching to countless numbers of people and wherever I turned around I saw multitudes. I was 17, when God call me to the ministry and two years later, I surrendered my life to do His service. At the age of 21, I began to serve God. For the past 40 years I've been walking with him and serving Him by His grace. God has taken me to more than 40 nations of the world in the 5 continents. Today by God's grace more than 700 churches have been established in India, Sri Lanka and Nepal and more than 40 social work has been carried out through our organization with thousands benefitted.

In my 60th year I started dreaming again and I have 60 dreams that I have written down. When I was 25 years old, God gave me many dreams and visions which I wrote down, And God has fulfilled them more than I could ask or imagine...

The ministerial roads have been rough with problems and tests. But God has been faithful. Once I was young, and now I am old. Yet I have never seen the Godly abandoned or their children begging for bread. (Psalms 37:25). I thank God for His faithfulness, for His goodness, for His providence and for what He has done through us in the past years. But as an organization and as an Individual, we are not satisfied with what we have achieved, but we want to pursue God's purposes and plans for our generation.

In the recent days, I read a book entitled "Circle Maker" by the author Mark Bateson. He has listed 100 things as the dreams of his life. He has written them to be fulfilled during his life time. So when I read that, God started talking to me. In my 60th year I started dreaming again and I have 60 dreams

that I have written down. When I was 25 years old, God gave me many dreams and visions which I wrote down, And God has fulfilled them more than I could ask or imagine. Now I have 60 dreams and only one out of that is the "Bethel City Cathedral" with a ten thousand people seater auditorium and the "Bethel Nagar". I would like to run my race with victory being blameless, without defect and holy. When I finish the race, I would like to hear God say, "Well done my good and faithful servant! I am well pleased with you".

The purposes in my life is to raise up the next generation for Jesus. *Psalms 22: 30, 31 Posterity will serve him; future generations will be told about the Lord? They will proclaim his righteousness, declaring to a people yet unborn: He has done it.*

My desire is to raise up generations that will live passionately for God and serve Him with Passion. Ministry is like a relay race, so it will not end here but go on. The generations after me, will serve God more. This ministry should be from generation to generation. We are standing on the shoulders of the giants. Our Parents served God in their generation. Now it is a great joy to serve God as a family, together. Now

the third Generation, both our sons are married and are serving Jesus and building the kingdom of God. Now their children, the fourth generation are getting ready to serve Jesus. Not only that I have a lot of spiritual sons and daughters and my desire is that they will also carry the vision of IPA and should go around the world planting churches and preaching the gospel.

This generation should see the power and might of God as in Psalms 71: 18 "Even when I am old and gray do not forsake me, my God, till I declare your power to the next generation, your mighty acts to all who are to come". This generation should know God and His power and His might. This is my desire that they should know how Great our God is and know the power of His resurrection! In my ministry I want the eyes of the people born blind to be opened, people from the wheel chair to be healed and rise up and walk. ceived a vision from God on their own like I did. They now conduct women conferences and meetings. I am very grateful to God for that.

God has also opened doors for me to do women's conference in other states. In Mumbai, we had 400 women in a 3 days conference. What touched me in that area was that even though we did not relate much to one another in terms of language and other things, we hugged one another and it gave a great joy of fulfillment. We also did one in Calcutta, Chandigarh and Karnataka.

Q: What do you think is the greatest aspect of transformation that has taken place today in the ministry of women in the church?

Knowing their stand and placement in the body of Christ according to the word of God. I would say it amazes me that women are operating in the anointing and gifting like being worship leaders, prophetess, evangelist, preachers, teachers and taking the lead.

Q: What is your vision for the women of the nation in the

future generation?

KP: My heart is to see that in the same country where women were suppressed more, God would lift them up the most and use them. Another vision that is in my heart is for young and old widows in the church. 15 years ago, we were caring and praying for 20 such women. Today we are able to care for around 250 widows.

Q: Inspirational Words you would like to leave for Women Leaders.

KP: Women need to be alongside their men being co-heris with them. They are in no way inferior to men. This is my strong conviction to let them understand this and also not to be like the worldly women – being aggressive and taking up women liberation, but move in a sweet way alongside their husbands - to be the best homemaker, best mother, best wife and helpmate.

I believe very strongly that every woman born in Christ is born for Victory, dignity and to enjoy God's best for their lives.
